

Invitation to service providers to submit their companies that are classified under the following disciplines (Youth owned companies, Women owned companies and People with Disabilities)

1. BACKGROUND

- 1.1. The Gauteng Partnership Fund (GPF) was founded in 2002 as a Benevolent Trust under the Trust Properties Control Act 57 (1988), by the Executive Authority of the GPF, Gauteng Department of Human Settlements. Gauteng Partnership Trust is trading as the Gauteng Partnership Fund (GPF):
- 1.2. 31 August 2005 GPF was listed as a Schedule 3C Provincial Public Entity (PPE), in terms of the Public Finance Management Act (Act 1 of 1999, as amended by Act 29 of 1999) (PFMA). The Gauteng Partnership Trust trading as Gauteng Partnership Fund (GPF) is a PFMA Schedule 3C provincial public entity under the Gauteng Department of Human Settlements (GDHS).
- 1.3. The mandate of the GPF is to serve as the Gauteng Department of Human Settlements (GDHS) capital raising and implementing agent of identified Mega Projects in the Gauteng Province. In 2002, the Gauteng Department of Housing (later configured as the Gauteng Department of Local Government and Housing, and since 2013 as the Gauteng Department of Human Settlements).

2. DISCUSSION

- 2.1. The Gauteng Provincial Government in its quest to promote local suppliers to participate in the main stream of the economy has taken a deliberate stance in promoting the local suppliers by focusing on the three identified designated groups that must be targeted when procuring goods and services. Those three groups are Woman, Youth and People leaving with Disabilities owned companies.
- 2.2. The GPF is inviting service providers who are interested in doing business to submit their company names in the format that is listed below. It must be emphasizes that only those that are within the identified designated groups as outlined in 2.1 will be accepted.
- 2.3. The GPF is aiming at establishing a database for those designated groups, most of the RFQ will be sourced through the established database in order to drive the agenda and targets for the Gauteng Province.
- 2.4. The service providers interested must be registered in the Central Supplier Database managed by the National Treasury for them to qualify to be in the database.
- 2.5. The below table depicts how the format of submission should be like.

- 2.7. The closing date of submission is 31st of March 2023.
